Fiber Arts Show Location: Queen Kaʻahumanu Center

PURPOSE

The Maui County Fair Fiber Arts Show celebrates the creativity and skill of our island's makers, from seasoned artisans to emerging talent. It encourages participation, inspires the next generation to explore the fiber arts, and offers our community a beautiful and inspiring showcase to enjoy.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to all Maui County residents.

DIVISIONS

- **Professional** Any exhibitor who has attained a high level of proficiency in their field of interest, but also receives monetary compensation. (ex: sells online, in person in a store or teaches)
- Kūpuna Age 65 and Over
- Adult Any exhibitor ages 18+ that is not professional
- Youth Age 12-17
- Keiki Age 5-11

SUBMISSION DEADLINE, DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

Submission Deadline: Friday, September 19, 2025

Submit Early: Space is limited. Entries received after capacity is reached will not be exhibited.

Drop-off: September 15–19, 9:00 am–4:00 pm, at the Maui County Fair Office trailer in the War Memorial Gym parking lot.

- Attach an identification label to the back of each item (labels at the end of this document)
- Bring your entry fees (\$5.00 per item)
- Items should be placed together in a large plastic bag to ensure they remain clean and organized.

Pick-up: Sunday, October 5, 4:00 pm–8:00 pm, at the Queen Ka'ahumanu Center exhibit location.

• The Fair is not responsible for items left after the release date.

Exhibit location details will be posted at **themauifair.com**.

FIBER ARTS ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. A nominal entry fee of \$5.00 per item helps fund the show, purchase ribbons, provide awards, and keep the fair sustainable.
- 2. Exhibitors may enter only one (1) item per Section but may enter multiple Sections.
- 3. Items must be entered in the Section where they fit best.
- 4. All items must have been completed in the past two years by the exhibitor.
- 5. Items may not have been entered in a previous competition.
- The Supervisor/Fair Management may refuse entries with objectionable content, unsuitable for judging, or requiring more space than available. No unfinished work accepted.
- 7. Items must be clean, pressed, blocked if needed, and free of soil, pet hair, or odor, or they will not be displayed or judged.
- 8. Items under 9" must be mounted on a fabric-covered board 2–3" larger than the piece.
- 9. Framed items are allowed (glass optional), but mounting on a board is preferred due to weight. The Fair is not responsible for damage to frames or framed work.
- 10. All exhibits must remain until official release; only assistants may remove entries.

AWARDS

Entries are grouped by **Division** (e.g. Adult), then by **Category** (e.g. Sewing), and finally by **Section** (e.g. Children's Clothing). Each Section is judged separately, with first, second, and third place prizes possible for each Division.

BEST OF SHOW AWARDS

One Best of Show may be awarded in each Category for each Division, if the judges determine the entry meets a high standard of excellence.

SPECIAL AWARDS

- **Grand Prize Award** Will be awarded to the single best exhibit in the Fiber Arts Show, as chosen by the judges and the department supervisor.
- **People's Choice Award** Will be awarded to the entry receiving the most votes from the public. Voting will be open in the Fiber Arts Exhibit Hall on October 4, and the winning entry will be announced and awarded on October 5.

FIBER ARTS JUDGING

- 1. The judges are instructed not to make awards unless the items are deemed worthy of merit. If any item is not worthy of the first place award, the judges may award second and third or none, according to their judgment.
- 2. Fiber Arts staff and judges may enter items for display only. They will not be judged.
- 3. Items entered into the Fiber Arts Show that are identical and entered by the same person will be disqualified.
- 4. Awards will be paid as indicated, unless specified otherwise.
- 5. If an item is entered into the wrong Section, the Judges may put it in the correct Section for judging.
- 6. Judges' decisions are final.
- 7. All judging will be closed to the public.
- 8. The following percentages will serve as a general guide to exhibitors of Fiber Arts, other than quilting, in preparing their exhibits. Please look at the Quilting section for judging guidelines.

1. Workmanship	40%
2. Tension (Thread/String/Cord/Yarn Divisions)	20%
3. Appearance	15%
4. Cleanliness - neatness, pressing, blocking	15%
5. Execution of Design	5%
6. Original Design	5%
